

Campus Trails and Natural Areas

Wetland Trails

2.3 Miles

The Wetland Trails extend west along an inlet to Panther Pond. This 4 acre pond is open for paddling but no swimming is allowed.

Tallgrass Trails

3.7 Miles

The Tallgrass Trails are located around the Tallgrass Prairie Center (TPC). These paths traverse 36 acres of production plots and tallgrass prairie used to grow native seed that is later distributed across the state.

South Campus Trails

5.8 Miles

The South Campus Trails offer a diverse selection of native ecosystems. Encompassing the University's Biological Preserves Complex, these trails are great for birding and native plant identification.
