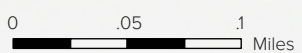

The UNI Biological Preserves have been a part of campus since 1970 when a committee formed to adopt this land and restore various native ecosystems of Iowa. Made up of over 80 acres and 5.8 miles of trail, the Biological Preserves are open year-round from sun-up to sun-down.
