Release fees are 2x market prices for grasses, 1.5x market prices for sedges and forbs. Fees are calculated based on PLS or TZ-PLS.

Seed lots vary in age; all have been stored at 40F and 45% RH. Lots older than 10 years discounted.

"Regrow" indicates species/zones that are in new TPC production fields but have not yet produced adequate seed for release.
